8	Correspondence – Guest Speakers: Ted Barton and Danielle Williams from the BC/YK Section Office.  Ted: Section has run 4 out of 5 virtual Region STAR Competitions, BCCR virtual Competition to be held May 14-15 followed by VDI virtual Competitive Competition to be held May 21-22. For the Star events- most results have been posted within 30 minutes after the end of the event. Virtual Competitions have now created an option going forward for Skaters unable to travel due to distance(cost) or weather condition. They can send in a video to be slotted into the competition.  The BC/YK Section is helping to enable other Sections to hold Virtual Competitions. The BC/YK Section is lucky to be the only Section to not have to deal with rink closures. All clubs have had the ability to offer most programs to their members, and the overall membership has not dropped as much as anticipated – biggest drop has been in Canskate numbers.	

**Danielle:** Reiterated current COVID-19 PHO restrictions: skaters must maintain 3m distance from each other, travel only to and from Home Club(one club) – cannot skate with multiple clubs (exception if you were skating at your home club, and at a synchro club before Dec 28<sup>th</sup>), for adult skaters – only 1 adult and 1 coach can be on the ice (2 skaters)

Virtual assessments are going well – 49 clubs have held assessment days so far. The Virtual assessments well be on-going. A notice will be sent out when we are able to hold them in-person again. The form to book an assessment day can be found on the Section website – please fill out, and the Section will then work with Skate Canada to set up your test day. Please allow a minimum of 3 weeks for this process. If there is an exposure/outbreak of COVID-19, you must advise the BC/YK Section, they need to be advised incase ViaSport or Provincial Health require the information. BC/YK Section AGM to be held virtually April 30<sup>th</sup>. Please register thru the Section website – 1 vote/club

Ice Summit to be held virtually May 28th-29<sup>th</sup>, with pre-event seminars starting the week of May 15<sup>th</sup> – seminars will cover a range of topics with something for clubs, coaches, and board members. All clubs and coaches have a vote. Please register thru the Skate Canada website. You will also find more details for the seminars there. Cost for the entire event is \$75.

## 9 Financial Report

The financial report was presented by Lyse Prendergast with explanation and discussion. COVID-19 had a huge impact on our ability to raise funds — with membership payback being our only real source of income - \$5599. We still had many fixed costs that need to be maintained, such as subscriptions to wufoo, zoom, constant contact, an upgrade to our accounting software, and the annual cost of our storage unit. Filing to become a Society this year also incurred fees. We were able to save a little with administrator's salary due to the lack of competitions, there was less work required.
